As you may be aware, the 2024 NAS Oceana Air Show will be held September 21-22, 2024. We would like to formally invite you to attend the **VIP/Special Needs Air Show on Friday, 20 September**. The Noblemen are once again proud to be associated with this great event and will be hosting all of our guests in the Noblemen Chalet located on the flight line at show center. The show begins at 10:00 and you may begin arriving at 9:30 am.

This year we are excited to announce that all of the air show performers will be encouraged to stop by the chalet before or after their performance to talk, sign autographs or to take pictures. The performers will include many of your favorites you have seen over the years and our local pilots based at NAS Oceana. The Blue Angels are currently scheduled to visit our tent at approximately 5pm.

We will be supplying pizza and water for lunch. This will be supplied at no cost to families. Also, the air show will be held rain or shine. We do not expect traffic to be a problem since this show is not open to the public.

To Get Your Parking Pass and to Enter the Base:

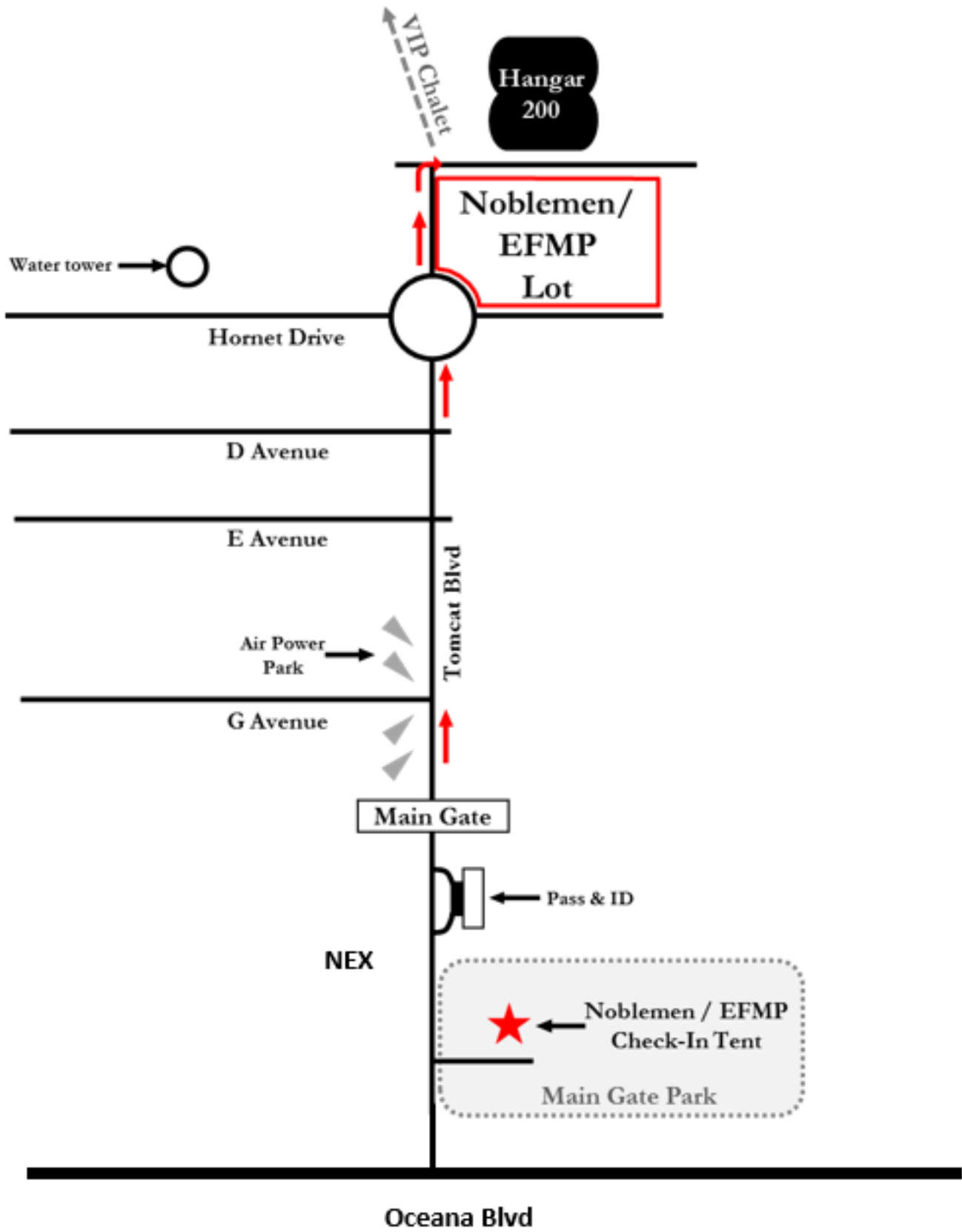
We will be at the Main Gate Park to hand out passes from 9am to 12noon on the day of the event, Friday September 20th. If for some reason you will need to pick up your pass prior to the day of the event you can contact me at 757-575-9090.

Base Access / Parking:

Guests will need a Noblemen Parking Pass to access the base and the designated parking lot for the show. We will supply these the day of the event at the Main Gate Park. Please enter the base through the Main Gate off of Oceana Blvd. If you need assistance there will be a Noblemen check-in tent at the entrance to Main Gate Park off of Tomcat Blvd.

Parking for Noblemen families will be located in a designated handicapped parking area located in a lot behind Hangar 200 (see map below; base security will direct you). Once you have parked in the lot, The Noblemen will be available to direct you to the VIP chalet and assist anyone who might need it. PLEASE NOTE: there are other handicap parking areas but you need to specifically follow the directions below to our parking behind Hanger 200.

NOTE: All adults 18 and older must have a physical photo ID when entering the flight line.



KEY POINTS TO REMEMBER

- You do not need to register or RSVP by name ahead of time. You are the guests of the Noblemen, EFM, Gold Star, or Navy Wounded Warrior.
- The only way to get on base with our group is by getting a pass to hang in your car
- You need to pick up this pass at the Main Gate Park which is immediately on your right when you turn onto Tomcat Blvd from Oceana Blvd. It is OUTSIDE of the security check point
- Look for our Noblemen and EFM tents at Main Gate Park
- We will only be there from 9am to noon the day of the Airshow (Friday only) to hand out these passes
- You only need one pass per vehicle – not per person
- All Adults age 18 and older must have a photo ID

Other Info:

- We suggest bringing **ear plugs or headphones** especially if your child has autism to help block the sound since we will be located on the flight line.
- We will do our best to give you a heads up before the Pyro explosions occur for those who are sensitive to loud and sudden noises. A Sensory Safe area will be available in Hangar 56.
- Wheelchairs, walkers, strollers, cell phones, handheld scanners, radios, small fanny packs, purses, cameras and camcorders WILL be allowed.
- Accessible toilets will be available close to the chalet.
- Ice chests, coolers, large bags, weapons, knives, alcoholic beverages, pets and glass containers are **NOT** allowed on base.
- **Medical personnel** will be on hand for this event.
